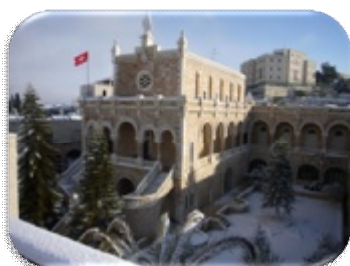

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Volunteers: a mission we always appreciate

For years, HFH had opened large doors to welcome volunteers from the entire world: Europe, United States, ...etc. Each and every volunteer was a committed person to the motive that drove him to leave his/her home country and arrive to Bethlehem.

They wore their badges and spread in the wards of the hospital, helping to give birth, guiding mothers to breastfeed, ran the food trolleys for patients and helped with bed-making, examined babies and neonates, and many other responsibilities that didn't stop them from living a humanitarian experience between the sick children and poor people we serve.

Through giving of their time and talents, enrich the healthcare experience of our patients and staff, their presence in the hospital created a cultural and experience exchange atmosphere. The knowledge of the Arabic language was poor among almost all volunteers, but this didn't prevent them from communicating with mothers with sympathy and care. "Although motivation may be different for each individual volunteer, a volunteer's moral strength and desire to help his fellow human beings, to practice international solidarity and to discover a new culture are essential to keep him going. Holding on to our motivation as volunteers is not always easy, especially when we are under stress or when our work becomes a deadly routine" – Dr. Jacques Keutgen / CEO



However, unfortunately the number of volunteers dropped dramatically during the past few years, volunteers could no longer obtain from the Israeli Authorities a long-term visa to stay in Bethlehem. They are no more able to commit for a period of six months or one year in Holy Family Hospital. From an average of 5 to 6 volunteers in 2008 to almost 1 or 2 volunteer in the following years and dropped to 0 volunteers in 2012! We do wish the concerned authorities interfere to help solve this issue rapidly.

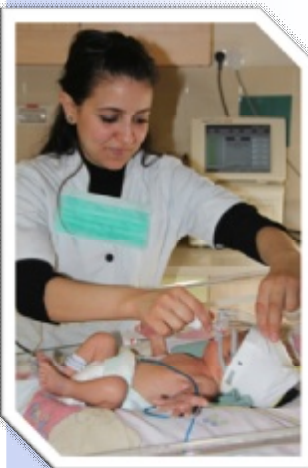
