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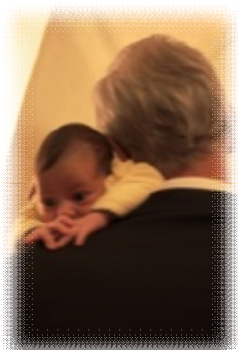
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EDITORIAL

In November, as every year the Board of Trustees of Holy Family Hospital held its annual meeting in Bethlehem. The Board meeting was preceded by meetings of the International Financial and Medical Committees. It is the occasion to sum up the financial and medical situation of the hospital and to ascertain if we are acting in accordance with our mission statement.

The year 2010 was marked by the 20th anniversary of the opening of Holy Family Hospital, the 50,000th delivery in our maternity and the opening in collaboration with Austrian Development Agency of a free- of- charge diabetic clinic for pregnant women. Over the years Holy Family Hospital has become a reality on the scene of health care for Palestinian women and infants and yet there is no time to rest on one's laurels because there are many other challenges which should be faced in the future.

For 2011 there are three main new goals to be achieved provided that we can find the necessary financial support from governmental or non-governmental organizations.

The first one is the urgent extension of our outreach mobile clinic providing educational services in addition to maternal health services to Bedouins settlements in remote areas in the Judean Desert.

The second one is the opening of a weekly free- of- charge gynecology clinic for women older than 45 years in order to treat all problems due to menopause ,consequences of multiple pregnancies like urine incontinence, prolaps etc...

The third one is the building of an incinerator for hospital waste. This is an acute health problem in Palestine because until now most of the hospital waste is put into the normal garbage.
