Continuous Educational Courses at HFH

On the 20th, 21st, 22nd February hand by hand Holy Family Hospital, with Juzoor Foundation held a training course located at Holy Family Hospital. (ALSO) training course focuses on the main emergencies that can happen in pregnancy and childbirth. Therefore, in this course a group of experts, specialists, doctors and midwives participated .

A total of 22 OBGYN residents and midwives were trained from different 5 hospitals mainly from the south area plus (Yatta, Beit Jala, Hebron, Holy Family & Makassed Hospitals). There were 8 qualified trainees from Holy Family Hospital. The training course focused on basic neonatal resuscitation skills (supported in part by Brigham and Young University through provision of manikins) it consisted of 1 day of Helping Babies Breathe, followed by 2 days of Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics. Both courses involve hands-on skills stations and written & practical exams.

The Director of Juzoor Foundation Dr. Salwa Najab declared that the main objective of this course is to work hard to protect the mother and the child birth, also to try to reduce the mortality rate in the Palestinian communities.



The new born angel shall bring in, loads of happy and memorable times in your life. Congratulations on the arrival of your new baby. God bless your family.




Group visit from France to HFH
