As part of providing the state of the art medical care to our new-born mainly the very premature; Anna-belle Kerjoant and Julie Courty, Ventilator & Monitoring systems experts, from Dräger Co through ARCOMED Co. visited Holy Family Hospital to upgrade our Medical Staff on using the new Ventilator system and the Patient monitoring system. The new Ventilator was donated through Holy Family Hospital of Bethlehem Foundation by a generous friend to our hospital.

The Neonatal Intensive care unit at Holy Family Hospital has a capacity of 18 bed, it provides medical care for the extreme premature born at Holy Family Hospital or out-born at nearby hospitals. In 2017, 432 premature received medical care at this unit.
