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During the past year there were some modifications in the management of stock in the pharmacy and in the different departments. The quantity of purchased items must be for the period of one month and not more, so as not to have big stock accumulated in the pharmacy. The orders from the departments are done on daily basis; the quantities ordered are for the use within 24 hours, without having any kind of stock. Each department has its own list with the limited quantities. And the used items are ordered the next day and delivered by the pharmacist. The stock and the In/Out movements are managed by computer system. Statistics of the consumption of each department and the amount of all the purchases are done monthly.


I would like to thank all the employees at our Hospital for the good relation between the pharmacy and the different departments which facilitates the work for everybody.

# A NEW Ultra Sound Machine



A new Color Doppler Ultrasound in the value of \$ 85,700 was received this month through the generous support of Holy Family Hospital of Bethlehem Foundation. This new ultrasound is replacing a fourteen year old ultrasound. The up to date technology will allow for a better diagnosis and sometimes lifesaving diagnosis due to early detection of Uterus Cancer for example. Good medical care provided to women supply the women with better quality of life that indirectly impacts the whole family since the mothers are the cornerstone in view of their role in creating the foundation of the family which is the structural unit of a society.
