Our guests also met with a few doctors and nurses who benefitted from USAID sponsored trainings though the past years. Along on the visit, representatives from EWAS (ANERA) joined us as well to present the works done in the hospital during the renovation phase.

For a brighter future for the women in Palestine

Through the training project funded by the USAID, Dr. Mai Dabodoub was sent to the *University of Maryland Medical Center–USA* to attend the Menopause conference "NAMS 22nd annual Meeting" conducted by the North American Menopause society (NAMS) in Washington DC as well as completing a one week training in their menopause clinics. The President of our International Medical Committee, Prof. Harry Johnson, who works in the OB/GYN Department at Maryland University, supervised and followed-up with her training. The hospital recognizes the necessity and the urging need to introduce the menopause service for the women in Palestine. Prof. Ronit Kochman and Prof. Drorit Hochner from Hadassah hospital are both interested and ready to assist in setting up a program for the Menopause clinic through Peres Peace Center in Israel. Hoping to get sufficient funds for this project, the hospital will introduce a menopause clinic to serve all women in the Bethlehem district and the surrounding villages.

Departure from the hospital

Dr. Yousef Abu Jreis, Head of the Anesthesia Department, resigned from his post at HFH. Dr. Yousef started working as an anesthetist in the hospital since 15th February 1991, and he headed the operating rooms. We thank him for the 20-years of service for the hospital and we wish him all success in his future endeavors.
