It's been a year since the first case of COVID19 was discovered in Palestine, Countries are racing to get their supply of vaccines, Palestine received very minimal amounts which is not enough to cover the medical staff working at the frontline. Around 22% to 25% of the people who test for COVID19 in the West bank appeared to be positive and the occupancy rate in the hospitals reached over the full occupancy, the frontline workers in the Palestinian hospitals are exhausted.

The high rate of infection in the community affected our Staff too, 22 staff members from different departments got infected and others were in quarantine. Our Staff have worked hard covering for workers who were sick or in quarantine. Their hard work kept the mothers and babies safe, a total of 357 babies were born and 26 babies were admitted to our Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.



### **BABY LILIAN**

Baby Lilian is finally ready to go home after spending 106 days at our Neonatal intensive



Care Unit.

Baby Lilian was born at gestational age of 27 weeks on December 20, 2020 weighing 500grams.

Baby Lilian decided to stay at our NICU during the hardest and riskiest period we are going through while being sever premature, very tinny and fragile, but the Staff of Holy Family Hospital provided baby Lilian with the best medical care they may provide, and finally baby Lilian went back home to join her siblings in good health on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 weighing 2.5 Kg.

COVID19 Swab was taken for all preemies and nurses at the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit as a precautionary measure to discover that baby Lilian is infected with Corona Virus. Thank God, the infection did not spread out to the other babies. Soon quickly, Baby Lilian was isolated and during each shift, a specialized nurse was dedicated to take care of baby Lilian for the full 14 days until she recovered. The extreme measures that were taken and the good use of the PPE's prevented the transmission of the Virus to other Staff or babies.



"Being Pregnant during COVID 19 Pandemic is a real challenge for us, adding to it a



baby born in sever prematurity, we were very worried, my nine months of pregnancy and the three months of Lilian's stay at the NICU were the most difficult days in my entire life. I am so grateful to Holy Family Hospital for the medical Services, the financial support and the psychological support that my daughter and I received especially at this time where COVID19 is spread everywhere and the risk of infection is high".

#### **PREGNANCY AND COVID19**

"At 29 weeks of pregnancy I was diagnosed with COVID19 and after few days I went into labor and headed directly to governmental hospital since they have a dedicated center for COVID19 patient treatment but being pregnant and in labor while only being 29 weeks of pregnancy, the hospital transferred me urgently to Holy Family Hospital being the only hospital who are capable to save the life of the severe premature".

"We were so afraid but upon arrival the medical team was waiting for us and ready; I was admitted to an Urgent Caesarean section and gave birth to baby Khaled, weighing 1.260 Kg"





"The team welcomed us with complete kindness, although my husband wasn't allowed to join me due to COVID19 restrictions, the team was so supportive and they all provided me with the needed medical information which made me feel in safe hands".

"Baby Khaled was admitted to the Intensive Care Unit and I was discharged home and was in quarantine for 14 days. This was the most difficult moment for me leaving my sick baby away from me, couldn't hug him, touch nor smell him". "The medical Staff at the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit were so supportive, I was able to contact them on Daily basis at whatever time and they were so kind to respond to my

calls and update me regarding the status of my baby, my baby was in safe hands, they treated him as a member of their family"

"I have witnessed high quality medical care, humanity, dignity, respect, I am so grateful to this hospital"
