the admission procedures, no one asked me for money nor for anything, all that matter to them was caring for my wife and daughter, I am so grateful for the care we receive at this hospital" Usama described.

Reina was born on 4th June, 2021, weighing 3.335, she was discharge home in a good health.

Pregnancy is a special time full of excitement and hope, but for Marianne and George, the COVID-19 pandemic surrounded this beautiful experience with fear, anxiety and uncertainty.



was examined by the Midwifes, my baby's pulse turned out to be weak, so she was admitted for an urgent Caesarean. At this moment, I felt lost, but what relieved me was the rapid medical intervention I witnessed. They succeeded in saving the life of my wife and my daughter's life"

During her pregnancy, Marianne was infected with COVID19, she was afraid of losing her baby, but by following up with her doctor at the Holy Family Hospital, she got through this phase safely.

On June 26th 2021, at 4:00 am, Marianne went into labour, she came directly to the Holy Family Hospital, the hospital staff contacted her doctor, who didn't hesitate for a moment to come.

As her husband described "When my wife

47 DAYS AT THE NEONATAL INTENSIVE CARE

After Spending 47 days at our Neonatal Intensive Care Unit baby Fatima is finally



ready to go home. Baby Fatima was born at 29 weeks of pregnancy on May 16th 2021, weighing 1.630 kg.

At 29 weeks of pregnancy, Noor Went into labour, so her husband took her to the nearest public hospital in Hebron. The doctors recommended that Noor should deliver at Holy Family hospital since the baby will admission to the Intensive Care unit at Holy Family Hospital since they are the only one qualified at caring of such preemies.

"It was a very hard decision to go to a hospital that I'm not familiar with, to deal with

and nurses without knowing them before, but thank God we took the right decision"

"It was very scary experience especially that we didn't know what was going to happen or what the outcome will be, but the staff of Holy Family Hospital provided my baby "Fatima" the best medical care they may provide, and finally baby Fatima went back home to join her two years old brother "Ali" in a good health on 30th June 2021"
