BABY HUTHAIFA

Pregnancy after a loss often brings mixed emotions. The tragedy of losing a baby can make it impossible for parents to go back thinking of pregnancy as a happy time that results in a healthy baby. Instead it can be filled with anxiety and fear.

Four years ago, Rehab's lost her pregnancy at 23 weeks gestational age.

Rehab is a Pediatrician at Caritas Baby Hospital. Rehab is Familiar with the high



medical care provided at Holy Family Hospital due to the cooperation between Caritas Baby Hospital and Holy Family Hospital.

On December 27th, 2021, at 25 weeks of pregnancy Rehab went into an early labor, and gave birth to baby Huthaifa weighing only 980 grams. The baby needed an intensive Care Unit.

"I am a proud preemie mom of a 25 weeks miracle, I spent a month of my life staring at my heart through an incubator. Before my child had the chance to experience the world, he had the task of fighting like warrior to stay alive. It is hard to watch. Prematurity is a pathway into parenthood that no mother or father ever expects to travel. I only experienced 25 weeks of my pregnancy, and I longed for the other 15. In the first few days after he was born, it was impossible to see the good in any of it", Rehab Described.

Luckily, the baby's situation is stable after one month of treatment, baby Huthaina weighs 1.350kg now, but unfortunately, he still need time at the Neonatal intensive care unit.

Rehab knows that her baby needs at least three months in the NICU department, as she is a pediatrician, but she knows that her baby is in safe hands at the Holy Family Hospital.

GOLDEN FIRST MINUTE PROGRAM

The birth of a newborn baby is delivering a new life into the world that can be one of the most rewarding and looked forward to calls. At the same time, it may cause some anxiety prior to and during the delivery. Few of the four million babies who are born




each year require some assistance to successfully transition to extra uterine life. This assistance should be provided in the first minute of the newborn's life.



Breathing on his / her own, or interventions must be initiated.

These 60 seconds of an infant's life are called The "Golden Minute" because it can influence all his entire life.



Believing that attention to women and infants around birth signifies a highly developed social compact and mature health system, the Holy Family Hospital is passionately committed to improving mother and newborn care and safety by providing continuously professional education program to our health care providers.

To ensure that healthcare providers remain up to date on advances in Neonatal resuscitation; the Neonatal Resuscitation Golden first minute program was introduced again by our Neonatologist *Dr.Micheline ALQassis* in

cooperation with Mr. Michel Lama, Quality & Assurance Coordinator, to equip all our Midwives, Nurses and doctors who are working in delivery room with knowledge and skills of the Neonatal Resuscitation and update themselves regularly in this regard.

The Fan coils are responsible to deliver cold air in summer and hot air in winter are connected to the main chiller. At the hospital, we have around 32 fan coils distributed in the Hospital's different facilities; main corridors, postnatal rooms, labor rooms, NICU, clinics and administration rooms. Our current fan coils were procured since 20 to 25 years and we were need to urgently change them. Thanks for the CNEWA- Pontifical Mission and holy family hospital of Bethlehem Foundation we were able to replace 17 of them.
