
ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE TRAINING


- How does infection spread and the cycle of infection.

On 20th July 2022, she felt labor pain and was admitted to an urgent Caesarean Section, and

gave birth to her third baby girl "AnnaMaria" Weighing (2490) kg.
