On 30th March 2023, Holy Family Hospital held a Ramadan Iftar for their employees.

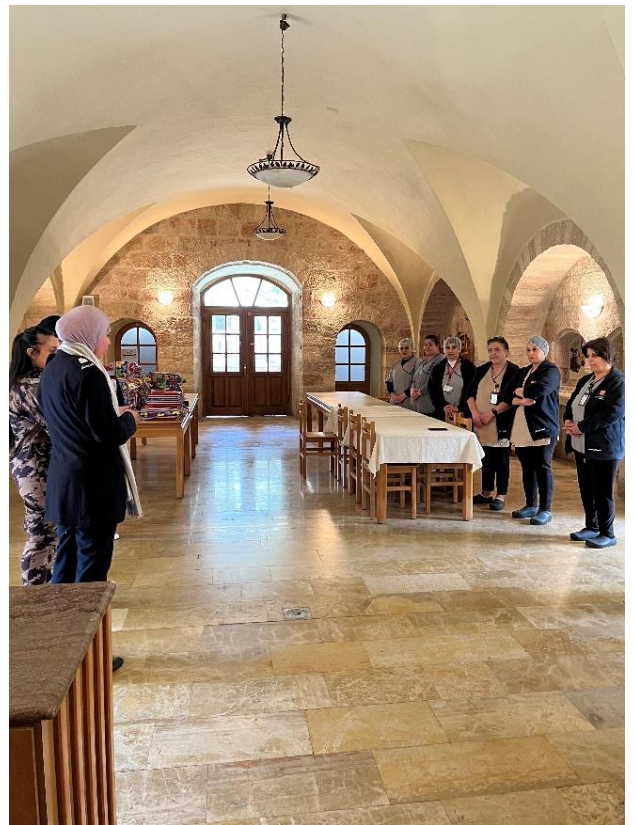
