During my stay at HFH, I improved my ability to work as part of a team of professionals and I gained immense confidence practicing neonatal medicine in an evidence-based environment.

Being at HFH has truly been a wonderful experience in my life.

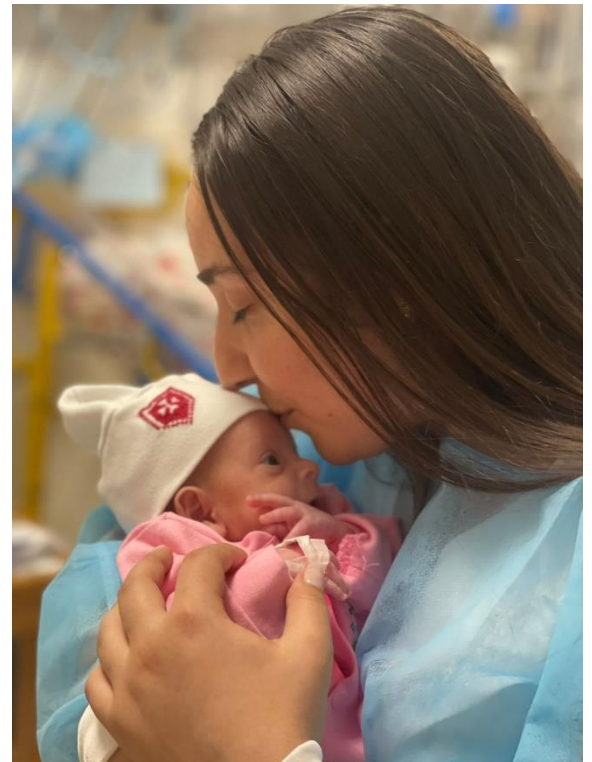
BABY MARIELLA

"While waiting in the hospital, "it seems like a lifetime, but you have to stay strong and know that your baby is in the best possible hands."

The Family was expecting the birth of their first child. On 33 weeks of pregnancy Jane expected to do a routine prenatal check-up at Holy Family Hospital. After the check-up, she was admitted for an emergency Caesarean Section to save her daughter's life.

As Jane Described "I didn't know what will happen with my daughter! But I was sure that my daughter's life will be saved by Holy Family's Hospital great team and doctors".

Mariella was born through an emergency caesarean section and weighed 1200 kg. When I heard her cry for the first time I felt a great wave of relief. But unfortunately, Mariella needed to stay in the Neonatal intensive Care Unit for 44 Days".



"Over time, the NICU turned into our second home, not only because they were caring for our baby, but also because the NICU staff made us feel at home, which is completely irreplaceable. Throughout the 44 days, it felt like home. We felt confidence and trust in the NICU Nursing Team and doctors.

On August 3rd 2023 , Mariella was discharged in a good health Weighing (1900) kg.

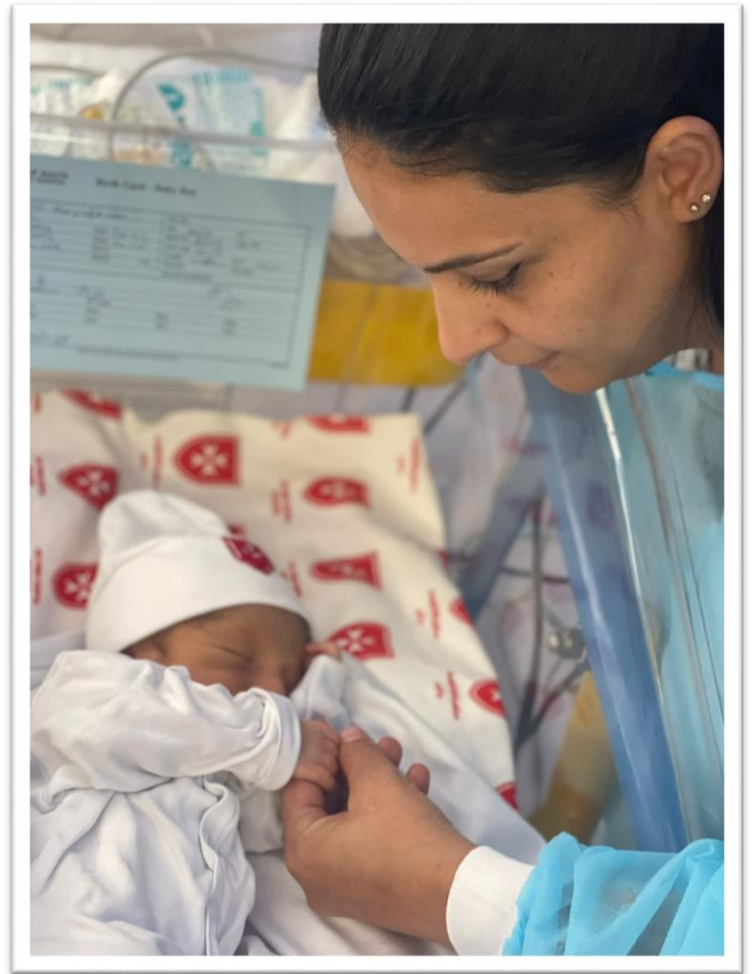
