French Consulate Ceremony

Five months after taking office, Nicolas Kassianides made the traditional visit to the Holy Sepulcher on January 11. Rooted in history, the ceremony is the responsibility of any new Consul General of France in Jerusalem and recalls its mission of protecting Christian communities. The CEO present at this was ceremony. A status guo from 1852 set the rules of life and liturgy for each community inside the Basilica. At the request of the Ottoman Empire, France is guardian of this status quo with the three other Latin nations of Italy, Spain and Belgium, but it is the only country which has the welcomed of privilege being solemnly to the Holy Sepulcher. But France also guarantees the protection of the Holy Family hospital and the consulate support for Christian institutions ensures this precious in the Holy Land. In total, there are 40 French religious communities and 130 educational, social and hospital institutions which are supported by France. Christian schools thus welcome 18% of students enrolled in Israel and Palestine. French protection translates into direct support and an advisory role in various areas, such as problems related to real estate, taxation, etc.











Volunteering Program

Due to the current conditions, many families have lost their source of income, especially workers who work in Israel and the workers of Bethlehem District in general. The idea of the project was created to save the family. With a member of each family, instead of providing material things that they might understand, it is kind and compassionate for them is to create job opportunities for one member of each family to work 20 hours a week, 80 hours a month in exchange for a sum of money to support the family.

The program is in cooperation with the Bible Society and St. Catharina Church

They were able to employ 45 families in various institutions in the area: Bethlehem, Beit Jala, and Beit Sahour.
